

Your guide to the international terminal at Seattle airport (SEA)



1

US Citizens / Returning ESTA holders (second or successive visits to US) on current passport from Visa Waiver country

Proceed to Customs Hall and use one of the Automated Passport Control kiosks.

All other nationalities / Visa Holders / ESTA Holders visiting the US for first time on current passport from Visa Waiver country

Proceed to Customs Hall and see an Officer in one of the booths.

Taking a connecting flight

You must collect your baggage, and clear Customs, even if it's tagged to your final destination.

If your baggage is checked to your final destination, and you are in possession of a boarding pass, follow the Orange lane after Customs, where your baggage will be placed on a transfer belt. Get your gate information from Flight Information Display Boards and proceed to the Security Checkpoint, then follow the map overleaf for your next flight.

Staying in Seattle?

Collect your bags, clear Customs and follow the Green lane for trains to the Main Terminal and Arrivals.

Please see overleaf for your handy map. Remember, you must pass through Customs and Immigration even if your bags have been tagged to your final destination.

Connecting from Delta flights to flight VS106 / DL4349 to London Heathrow?

Please check your gate on the nearest Flight Information Display Screens and follow the map below.

The flight is operated by Virgin Atlantic, and generally departs from the S- or A-concourse.
